ICT EDUCATORS COMMITTEE

1. ROLE

- a. Provide thought leadership and commentary on technology education pedagogy and issues impacting student attainment in Digital Technologies, in order to improve the learning outcomes of the students who will become future ICT professionals; and
- b. Provide professional advice and recommendations on the development of high-quality learning resources that assist K-12 Educators implement the Digital Technologies curriculum in Australia.

2. MEMBERSHIP

- a. A Chair appointed by the Management Committee on the recommendation of the VP, Membership and the Director, PAB;
- b. Up to 7 (seven) members of the profession who are currently (or recently) engaged in the teaching of Digital Technologies or related K-12 education, appointed by the Management Committee on the recommendation of the VP, Membership and the Director, PAB; and
- c. The PAB Director may attend any meeting and assume the role of Chair.
