1. ROLE

- a. Provide professional advice and strategic recommendations to the Profession Advisory Board (PAB) on ACS education programmes and activities which lead to formal outcomes or qualifications; and
- b. Provide independent quality advice on all ACS educational products and offerings, with the authority to request reports, policies and procedures regarding such products and offerings.

2. MEMBERSHIP

- a. A Chair appointed by the Management Committee on the recommendation of the VP, Membership and the Director, PAB;
- b. Up to 7 (seven) members of the profession who are currently (or recently) engaged in ICT practice in the private or public sector with experience in Professional Education appointed by the Management Committee on the recommendation of the VP, Membership and the Director, PAB; and
- c. The PAB Director may attend any meeting and assume the role of Chair

3. REVIEW

- a. This document is due for review by the Management Committee at its first meeting in 2021; and
- b. Minor changes may be approved by the Custodian, e.g. the correction of typographical or formatting errors.
