

Project ManagementOnline Course

This course will be valuable for motivated IT practitioners who wish to undertake postgraduate study.

Course content

Project Management covers the principles of project management, stages of a typical project, the skills required to be a good project manager and common issues. The focus is on giving you the knowledge and ability to be able to deal with everything, all the time.

It includes four modules, which explore:

- Challenges in projects and the role of the project manager
- The triple constraints scope, time and cost management
- General issues understanding people, organising teams, communication, quality management and risk management
- Dealing with multiple projects and closing projects.

Learning outcomes

- Understand the impact of culture, systems and organisational structure on project management processes.
- A working knowledge of project management processes, including project initiation, planning, execution, control and closure.
- Understand the importance of people skills and the need to involve stakeholders.
- Apply specific project management techniques such as risk analysis, estimation techniques, and stakeholder and value analysis.
- Explain the nature of project risk, the consequences of unmanaged risks, and the special challenges of risk management in software projects.
- Apply methods for directing and managing complete portfolios of projects, as well as individual projects.

Motivated IT practitioners who wish to undertake postgraduate study to increase their knowledge and career opportunities.
