



# Understanding the ACS Result Letter

ACS outcome letters are issued via the Applicant portal (or Agent portal if you have an authorised agent) at the completion of your ACS Migration Skills Assessment.

You will be notified via email once this process has been completed and the outcome has been sent.

You will receive a separate letter for each suitable ANZSCO code (up to 3). A suitable result letter can be submitted as evidence of a successful skills assessment to the Department of Home Affairs.

If applicable, you will receive a single letter with all unsuitable ANZSCO codes (up to 3) with the reasons detailed.

## First page

The first page will state the outcome, suitable or unsuitable, and the ANZSCO code or codes (up to 3) covered in this letter along with the [Skill Level Requirement Met Date](#) which are determined by the ACS suitability criteria (where applicable).

### Breakdown of individual ANZSCO codes

The next section of your letter will provide a detailed breakdown of qualifications and/or experience that are closely related or not closely related to the nominated ANZSCO code or codes.

### Breakdown of unsuitable qualifications or experience

The next section will list the qualification(s) and/or experience that did not meet the suitability criteria combined.
